Palm Beach's Worcester success reads well and he commands respect off 7lb higher on debut for new connections. Divilabother and Lone Star are others to consider.

Point-to-point winner Killybegs Jet Lady has posted several creditable efforts in defeat over hurdles this season and is also worth a second look on her chase bow.

The Churchill gelding slipped up midway through that contest and, given his previous triumph over track and trip, isn't taken lightly. Believe Jack may fare best of the remainder.
