PREVIEW: GREAT FLEET shaped with encouragement on his first two hurdle outings when chasing home Conman John here and at Cheltenham over further. Dan Skelton's gelding subsequently ran flat when returning to the latter venue in Grade 2 company and the application of a tongue tie may aid his cause, especially with his sights being lowered. Bohemond Antioch could settle better with his return at Bangor under his belt, while Carlisle bumper winner Camberwell can take a step back in the right direction on hurdling debut.

The seven-year-old was runner-up to Nells Son in this contest last year before following up in a Windsor handicap off a 2lb higher mark and, despite being 3lb worse off this time around with Nicky Richards' gelding, he has every chance of getting back to winning ways. Saint Segal was runner-up in the Haldon Gold Cup behind a hugely progressive rival and commands respect, while dropping back in trip may benefit The Other Mozzie.
