Maxi King commands respect but has a stiff test under top-weight. Therefore, fellow three-year-old Cape Breton could be a bigger danger back over this distance.

Harriet Quimby has an appealing pedigree and should also be wiser after her debut third at Nottingham, while Light The Night Up has some course experience and is a potential improver stepping up in trip.
