Any market confidence behind hurdling newcomer Dayzee would be interesting.

Of the others, Tapley is a two-time C&D winner on an attractive mark and he's noted along with the lightly-raced Paul Nicholls inmate Nardaran.

PREVIEW: STAMINA CHOPE is the sole C&D winner in the field and that will stand her in good stead off a light weight. Third at Worcester in August, she certainly showed a lot more when fourth here last month as she was beaten a little over two lengths and perhaps given a bit too much to do. Dave Roberts' charge seems to be coming back to her best and makes more appeal than Hurst Hill, who enjoyed a profitable summer campaign. Keep an eye on Kottayam too.
