PREVIEW: Having displayed a willing attitude to score at Leicester a fortnight ago, Enpassant cannot be ruled out on his follow-up bid. However, a 3lb nudge up in the ratings does demand more from Michael Herrington's inmate and COURT OF SESSION may prove to be slightly better handicapped. The six-year-old arrives on the back of a respectable third over an inadequate 5f here and an extra quarter-mile distance may prove fruitful. Oh So Audacious and Triggered could make their presence felt too.
