**PREVIEW:** Stepping up distance has been profitable for TWILIGHT MOON, who is two from two over 1m4f and has a major chance of completing a hat-trick off just 3lb higher than for a game success at Leicester a fortnight ago. Percy's Daydream struck at the same venue most recently, but a 5lb rise demands more of her. With that in mind, five-time course winner Dr Rio is suggested as a bigger danger to the selection.
