**PREVIEW COMMENT:** FRANCILIEN has maintained form and consistency at a higher level and she is open to any amount of improvement after a lengthy absence. KOMATI RIVER fits a similar profile so must be respected. Unexposed PRETTY PERSUASIVE receives chunks of weight from those older rivals and should have more to offer on her reappearance. SUMMER WINTER and SAIGON SUZIE also have the form and experience to get involved.

With the winner going on to place twice at Group 3 level and finishing fourth in the Coronation, the form has a solid look to it and her trainer can get one ready after an absence. Rock Iguana looks her biggest rival after a close-up Wolverhampton third, although Shamacid ran well for a long way on his debut and can only improve for the experience.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** RIFLE QUEEN, one of 4 last-start winners in the line-up, outran market expectations when beating male opposition on debut (runner-up has won since). She would have benefitted from that experience and is open to any amount of improvement, so it should pay to follow her progress. ON THE RUN and stable companion BLUSHING BLOOM are improving fillies with scope for further progress. Gavin Lerena rode both to victory last time out so riding arrangements would suggest the latter is preferred. Recent runner-up PRINCESS LOLA can also make her presence felt.

Lord Montague only went under by a neck at Lingfield and is another who can go well, but FIRST AMBITION could have their measure. Karl Burke's gelding ran on well to win over 7f in the Newcastle event in which Great Dream was third and can only improve for both the run and the extra furlong.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** RODEO DRIVE is proven at this level and better suited to this distance, over which she finished 2nd at Grade 1 level as a juvenile. BJORN IRONSIDE races well fresh and is weightd to be competitive on his reappearance. NYAKA NYAKA showed promise as a 2yo, has scope to improve, and the form to make his presence felt. BAKWENA, FROZEN FANTASY and PRINCE OF KILDARE shouldn't be far off the mark.
