PREVIEW COMMENT: Stablemates RED PENNY and EIGHT HATS contested features last season during promising 2yo campaigns and both are open to improvement this term. However, they concede weight to maturing older rival XENOPHON. The well-bred latter is also on an upward trajectory and could represent Each-way value. BOSUM BUDDY, PENNSYLVANIA and versatile HONG KONG (blinker strikel) aren't taken lightly.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Schrodinger's Cat brings plenty of experience to the table and sets the standard with an official rating of 78, but he has failed to justify favouritism in each of his last two starts and NOBLE VOW makes more appeal. Richard Hannon's colt shaped with promise when third on debut over 6f at Salisbury and if the son of No Nay Never takes a step forward from that performance, he could prove hard to beat. Any market support behind newcomer Lady Kodiak would be interesting.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Port Darwin ran better than his finishing position suggests when fifth in maiden company at Beverley. He raced up with the pace for a long way before fading in the closing stages, and the son of Australia could prove better than his opening mark now handicapping. Panthere Noir is another to note on his nursery debut, while Lexington Express has a shout on last month's third at Chepstow.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Hanney Girl got off the mark at the fifth time of asking at Beverley last month and has her first attempt at a nursery. Straight Ahead showed progression when second at Musselburgh and is noted, but SINJ is worth another chance. The daughter of Too Darn Hot failed to live up to market expectations when only fourth at Thirsk, but can be excused as she bled from the nose. Off an unchanged rating, she could bounce back to score.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Promising PALACE PRINCE acquitted himself well at a higher level of the handicap as a 2yo last season so this ease in grade (off a slightly reduced mark) represents a good opportunity for him to resume winning ways. Last-start winners TIME WILL TELL and JET CAT should be competitive for Swinger and Exacta berths, while hard-knockers TOGETHER AGAIN, ORIENTAL BOUQUET and STROKE OF MERCY are others to consider for Trifecta and Quartet bets.

SELECTION: 1 AFTER HOURS 12 COMMANDER OF ALL 3 COPPOLA 9 GAMER
PREVIEW COMMENT: Veteran hard-knocker AFTER HOURS defied a 3-point penalty for winning at this level by following up against stronger opposition last time and a further 4-point rise back in this grade is unlikely to prevent him from completing the hat-trick. COPPOLA, class-dropper PANNING GOLD, hard-knockers FLAG BEARER and GAMER, as well as consistent ZOOMBOMBER all have earning potential. However, a bigger threat to the selection will likely come from COMMANDER OF ALL who stayed on to finish a close-up 3rd last time and is 2kg better off with his last-start conqueror for a 2.05-length beating.
