**PREVIEW COMMENT:** INVICTUS JET made good improvement staying on well when tried over 1750m and could be even better over 1900m. She carries a light weight and has the best of the draws. CALL ME WILD is looking to go one better after finishing runner-up in his last two. He is drawn in stall No 2 and could take it to the wire. LIMELIGHT LEGEND has good form and could be the older runner that will test this field. He will, however, need the race run to suit from the widest draw. FINE WINE hasn't enjoyed the Poly of late and could suddenly show back on turf.

The son of Earthlight beat a useful rival that day and might be up to the task here. Others to note include Saxophonist and Be The Standard.

The former has No 1 draw but is giving weight to all, carrying top weight, and may have his work cut out. ZARA'S WINTER is open to improvement after running on late when trying 1800m. If seeing out the extra he should have every chance. KING CELTILLUS met winners when beaten by useful mare Escapologist last time. He may step up on form back in maiden company. CALL ME HARRIET wouldn't be winning out of turn as she is knocking at the door.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** FUTURE VARIETY is in top form and could make it three wins on the bounce. He loves Hollywoodbets Greyville and his running style suggests he will have no problem with 1400m. DIANI is narrowly best weighted, also has a good record at Greyville and he is proven over the distance. Watch out for GIMMEANOTHERCHANCE who is a past Listed winner over the course and distance. But along with DIANI he has a bit more to do jumping from wider out. IMILENZEYOKUDUDUMA and THE SHEPHERD are both capable of being in the fight too.
