PREVIEW COMMENT: Top horse SEE IT AGAIN is back and along with Betway Summer Cup winner ROYAL VICTORY will attract horseplayers. SEE IT AGAIN races fresh and could get back to the winner's enclosure in this kind of contest before a tilt at the big races. ROYAL VICTORY should find it short but could earn some money. ON MY HONOUR has lifted his game over ground but is also capable of turning in a good performance over this shorter distance. GIMMEFABULOUS and stablemate CLAW have ability and need to be watched. Youngster BRUH must be respected with a light weight.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Two-time course winner Rare Edition was last seen falling in this sphere in a warmer event at Doncaster, but has to be of interest off 1lb lower on his return. However, BOURBALI finished a creditable third in a class 2 handicap over 2m5f at Newton Abbot in May and may appreciate this drop back in trip. Joe Tizzard's charge competes off a workable rating and could prove hard to beat. Bad also has a chance.

Jennie Candlish's charge isn't taken lightly reverting to fences from a 3lb lower rating, but RED DELTA may offer slightly better value. The six-year-old finished a good second in the Champion Novices' Hunters' Chase at Stratford in May and an opening mark of 108 could prove lenient. The returning Ballylinch is the pick of the remainder.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Unbeaten WILD JUSTICE is given more of a task in this highly competitive B Stakes. He is still unexposed and may just enjoy the turn. Specialist SUPER FAST will not make things easy. He lived up to his name last time and is arguably better on the grass track at this venue. ICY BLAST showed guts to win and having drawn well again must be respected. HIERKOMMIEBOKKIE is best weighted and has gate No 1. If she is in the right mood she could be right there. ISIKWISHIKWISHI and TARA STAR (loves the track) aren't without claims either. Nice race.

That was the seven-year-old's fifth victory in his last six outings and he looks capable of defying a 9lb hike in the ratings. Fairlawn Flyer has also enjoyed a productive year and found only a subsequent winner too strong at Cartmel in July. However, Mickey Bowen's charge is sitting on a career-high mark and Newton Abbot winner Bagheera Ginge may give the selection most to think about.

PREVIEW COMMENT: The last race could be the toughest, get your TAB Quartet bets on! FATE OR FORTUNE wasn't beaten far by a smart youngster last time. He is in good form and must be included in all bets. BOOM SHAKALAKA has won over the distance and could prove to be a bit more competitive in this lower division. He is racing after a rest but has drawn well. YANNAKIS won a nice race in his penultimate start and is worth another chance. CATAVAR has been doing well over 1000m and yet should be better over 1200m-he could show up strongly. NAVAJO DANCER is one of many that can earn.
