**SELECTION:** 7 DRIVELIKEAMASTER 9 PALACE REVOLT 6 ANTONIO GAUDI 4 TURBO POWER  
**PREVIEW COMMENT:** Another competitive handicap. DRIVELIKEAMASTER showed good pace in his second run after a rest and should be at his peak and ready to give of his best. PALACE REVOLT has been thereabouts recently but earlier turned in a few decent performances. He looks a big threat at the weights. ANTONIO GAUDI finished second last time and did have some hard-luck stories then. TURBO POWER ran well in his first run after a rest. He is back over his best distance and could test this field. Most have claims. FALCON STRIKE is capable of better but will need to improve on his latest form.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** Although still 7lb above his highest winning mark, it might be worth giving another chance to HIGHFIELD VIKING. The gelded son of Aclain had to settle for third when sent off joint-favourite for a class 4 at Catterick, but he has less on his plate now and can go close from 1lb lower. The consistent King's School remains unexposed on turf and could be capable of better, as could the three-year-old Tactical Plan.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** PRESLEY ran on really well to take the second cheque in what was a tough race last time. He carries top weight but could nevertheless be up to the task. DYLAN'S CHAMP showed good resolve to win over 1600m last time. He is in good form and may not mind the drop to 1400m. DECEPTION PASS has a few lengths to find on DYLAN'S CHAMP but his last run was decent and must be respected. ZANTHAR has dropped in merit ratings and now has a 2.5kg apprentice claim and could be the dark horse. JORDAN could benefit from a decent pace. JURY'S OUT is another that can take it.

Obito has held his form since his Ayr victory in August and commands plenty of respect along with Project Geofin, who shaped well when fourth off this mark at York last time.

PREVIEW COMMENT: GAMER has been in good form and could finally win at this course. He does have more to do at the weights. It has been a while since COMMANDER OF ALL won but he has been knocking at the door and should have every chance at the weights. OKLAHOMA TWISTER won a nice in his penultimate start and then followed that up with a fair race against stronger. He looks to have a big say. SHEETS AND GOGGLES is another that didn't disgrace himself at a higher level and comes into it. BLURRED VISION and VAVA VEGAS didn't give in over further last time. MAJALUN could prefer the drop in trip.
