MIDNIGHT LADY, LA LONDONNE and ACT OF GRACE are all in good form and would not be surprise winners. WILLIAM'S WOMAN has not been disgraced so far and could play a minor role.

The impressive winner over 3m4f at Cheltenham in April, Evan Williams' charge returned to action with a victory at Chepstow in October and another good effort looks assured. This longer trip holds no fears for Invincible Nao, who scored over 2m4f here last month, while Midlands National runner-up Tanganyika makes more appeal than O'Connell and Hung Jury, despite carrying top weight.

PREVIEW COMMENT: A very open last race. Eastern Cape raider SPORTS FAN found a speedy filly too fast for her last time but does seem suited to this course and distance and could run well. PINK PIGEON has shown improvement of late and can get into the finish once again. PARALEGAL and LOVE SHACK do not always show their best form but are capable of making the frame. PEACE OF MIND and DAME OF TRIX are in good form and are clearly not out of it. CLAIR DE LUNE, CATCH A PENNY and LADY LOOK ALIKE are consistent and also capable of winning.
