PREVIEW COMMENT: Well-related PALACE ATTACK is on the up and open to further improvement over this extended trip so it could pay to follow his progress and side with him over consistent OPEN HIGHWAY (blinkers on) who would not be winning out of turn after a last-start 2nd over track and trip. Recent Polytrack scorer OMBUDSMAN and consistent PRINCE OF KILDARE also remain competitive off their current marks. ZANTHAR, SEA SHANTY and IMPACT INVESTOR have the means to get involved too.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Haas Boy hasn't looked back since racing under the tutelage of Chester Williams and merits respect in his hat-trick bid. However, a 5lb higher mark on this rise in class does demand more and preference is for DON'T MIND IF I DO. The five-year-old was a bit too fresh on his third-placed seasonal debut over 2m1f at Aintree last month and this ease in distance looks ideal. Clap Of Thunder could also play a leading role.

PREVIEW COMMENT: GIMMETHGOODLIFE has gone from strength to strength since joining the Peter yard. He races off a career-high mark after a last-start victory but should remain competitive.

KING OF VENUS, LEAD THE CHARGE and ESQUEVELLE are weighted to pose more of a threat to their recent conqueror on these terms. ONE EYE ON VEGAS stayed on from a long way back (wide draw) to finish 4th in a 1400m Grade 3 last time and this shorter trip won't hold any fears. Stablemate MIAMI MOUNTAIN ran in that race too and will appreciate reverting to a sprint distance. WAR OF KINGDOMS fits a similar profile so is respected.

PREVIEW COMMENT: DE LEGISLATOR has shaped as though a test of this nature would bring out the very best in him. Twice a winner over fences at Ayr and Wetherby, the eight-year-old has been particularly strong at the finish on both occasions and a 6lb rise for the latest success doesn't appear to be insurmountable. Diamond Dealer arrives with an unbeaten record over fences and is likely to enter calculations along with top-weight Cadell and Gold Clermont.

PREVIEW COMMENT: BUMPS LAST GRIND had legitimate excuses for his disappointing showing last time and a subsequent 92-day break would've done him good. On the strength and consistency of his earlier form, he should take advantage of this drop in class under a 4kg claimer. Fellow class-droppers CLAIRWOOD ROSE and INAFIX should also acquit themselves competitively at this level off reduced marks. HIS LORDSHIP and recent runner-up, albeit at a lower level, NKANDLA GOLD have earning potential too.

PREVIEW COMMENT: 2024 Derby runner-up AMBIENTE FRIENDLY should have learned plenty from his fourth-placed hurdle debut at Cheltenham and makes grand appeal. The four-year-old showed signs of inexperience and this emphasis on speed is likely to suit. Wondering Why arrives on the back of a promising third at Southwell and may give the selection most to think about, although it would be no surprise to see Bobajob bounce back to form tackling timber for the first time.
