PREVIEW COMMENT: Another cracking contest. TALK TO THE MASTER sets the standard bringing high-class form from the Western Cape. He makes his debut for trainer Dom Zaki and he could win if ready after a long break. WILD JUSTICE showed his field a clean pair of heels last time and with his confidence back up he could do it again. MAJOR TOMMIE was beaten 3.60 lengths by WILD JUSTICE but could be dangerous this time as he is 3kg better off and has the inside gate. Specialist LICENCE TO THRILL and CIRCUMBENDIBUS can't be discounted. COWBOY COUNTRY has scope.

PREVIEW COMMENT: SHUTTLE DIPLOMACY isn't the most consistent of performers but did win twice in bumpers, including at this venue, and was placed behind Bambino Fever at the Cheltenham Festival. The Tom Cooper-trained gelding put a couple of disappointing efforts over hurdles behind him when second in a strong maiden at the Limerick Christmas meeting. Point-to-point winner Newbrook Diamond has been placed on all three hurdle starts, including when runner-up to Future Prospect here earlier this month, while Kilgame is another to consider on his third to Murat at Leopardstown. Arcadian Emperor won a Lismore point in good style and now switches to hurdles after finishing fourth in a Leopardstown bumper.

Nicky Richards' mare has to contend with a 12lb penalty, but this appears a fine opportunity for her to bounce back. Rosie Baloo has been knocking on the door and finished second at Wetherby on Boxing Day. She enters calculations along with Laffer Curve, who was back in fourth on that occasion.

SELECTION: 5 WINTER RAINFALL 9 BUTTERCUP BABY 13 FASCINATION 2 LIGHT OF GABRIEL PREVIEW COMMENT: WINTER RAINFALL is knocking at the door and it could be the right race for her to get her head in front again. She has lacked early pace and blinkers will be fitted. BUTTERCUP BABY has won some nice races and accordingly has gone up in ratings. A 4kg apprentice claim could keep her in the limelight. FASCINATION has run two solid races in a row and would be deserving. She carries a light weight but jumps from a wide draw. LIGHT OF GABRIEL has drawn well on the other hand and must be respected. Stablemates SIESTA SUNSET and SOVEREIGN GRANT can threaten too.

PREVIEW COMMENT: CLUB MANAGER has proved frustrating to follow this season, filling the runner-up spot three times including behind River Vale here last month, with King Kali five lengths back in fourth. The Ross O'Sullivan-trained gelding handles testing ground and cheekpieces are now replaced by blinkers. King Kali has won either side of the aforementioned outing including at the Limerick Christmas meeting, with Peaceinthevalley behind in fourth, while Matt Connor won on his penultimate start at Limerick and again put in a solid effort at Leopardstown last time. Mystic Malina and Mon Sheriffe are others to consider.

PREVIEW COMMENT: At first glance it looks wide open. But CHRISTMAS CACTUS gave the impression he could be looking for the distance when running on late to win his third start. The switch to Hollywoodbets Scottsville could suit. SWORD SPEED is another youngster that has done little wrong. But he will need to overcome the widest stall to win. SEND ME made good improvement staying on well in second last time and if holding form could appreciate the extra. RAGNAR THE KING is a lot better than his last two performances. His merit rating has dropped and he may just be the value proposition.
