**PREVIEW COMMENT:** CHRONICLE KING (Grade 1-placed 2yo) acquitted himself well in defeat in back-to-back features before an 11-week break. He has a good record racing fresh and should play a leading role. JIMMY DON is the best-weighted runner in the lineup but unlikely to be at his peak in his second outing after a lengthy layoff, so last-start winner KING HARALD and consistent DANCE KING should pose more of a threat. GERBERA could improve fitted with cheekpieces for the first time so cannot be underestimated either.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** Last year's winner SPYCATCHER has got better with age and although he picks up a 5lb penalty for winning a Group 3 in France, he could be up to the task given he carried the same burden when he won the Wentworth over C&D when last seen. Montassib, who won this in 2024, could only manage fifth in that race and may again find the Karl Burke-trained gelding to be his nemesis. My Mate Alfie is a notable alternative on debut for David O'Meara, while Jasour drops in class and is dangerous to ignore.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** PRECOCIOUS has thrived on the Highveld, winning four times since relocating from the Western Cape, including both course-and-distance outings and all 3 starts under apprentice Blaine Marx-Jacobson. She could improve sufficiently to defy another penalty (career-high mark) and unfavourable weight turnarounds. MYSTICAL MISS is weighted to turn the tables on her last-start conqueror and is open to improvement in first-time cheekpieces. THERE SHE GOES and BOSUM BUDDY have the form and experience to make their presence felt too. Unexposed FIERY ROSE isn't taken lightly on her handicap debut after a break.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** Not one favourite has obliged in this over the last 10 years, which doesn't bode particularly well for Mezcala, who was the subject of good early support at declaration time. Jack Channon's four-year-old is unexposed and may well have sufficient ability to buck the trend but there are some very vily characters amassed and preference is for DESPERATE DAN, who was last seen registering a gutsy victory over C&D in October. Lir Speciale also enters the equation having won a brace of 7f events here last autumn. Carron, Pressure's On and Classic Encounter all have each-way prospects.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** BLINDFIRE ran well in defeat against male opposition last time and a repeat of that performance back in same-sex company will put her right in the firing line. Fellow 3yo fillies TEMPRANILLO and LOVABLE have fewer miles on the clock and won't need to improve much to get into the picture. Class-droppers SHE'S ALL MINE and KIA KAHA should make their presence felt in this grade off reduced ratings. MY DEAR FRIEND is another to consider on her handicap debut.
