He should readily cope with the step up in grade. Ipanema Queen won a recent course Listed contest over 5f, but is vulnerable to an exciting type. Mushaffar won a median sires maiden on his introduction here, but steps up to a much higher level.

PREVIEW: The 90-rated MO GHILLE MAR looks the pick at the weights here. The Zoffany filly ran a solid race in handicap company at Killarmey last time and despite being eased a couple of pounds is still by rated here. Mordor was no match for easy winner Kyle of Lochalsh over in Goodwood at the start of the month but it was still a solid effort in second. He is rated 88 but does have to give the filly 5lb. Jungle Cove is a regular in these types of races and could be place material.
