**PREVIEW:** THEDEVILUNO has proven to be a consistent performer and arrives here on the back of a second in Grade 2 company over 2m4f at Navan. The seven-year-old may improve for this step up in trip and should not be underestimated. Rocking Man beat Carlenrig when they met in a Chepstow maiden hurdle in November, but the runner-up went on to win at this level at Cheltenham. With that in mind, Dan Skelton's charge may be able to reverse the form, despite a 5lb penalty.

The Joel Parkinson & Sue Smith-trained gelding was impressive when landing the Tommy Whittle and a 10lb hike looks surmountable. Last year's winner Do cpickedme and Josh The Boss are others of interest.

PREVIEW: Point-to-point winner Elderflower Tonic changed hands for 80,000 pounds in November and would be of interest if the market speaks in her favour. However, HOBBSON'S DAY shaped with promise when second on his introduction at Newton Abbot and would have learned a great deal from that experience. If the six-year-old takes a step forward, he could prove hard to beat. Twenties Icon is another to keep an eye on.
