Stable companion HAPPY WIVES is better than what she has been showing of late and could contest the finish. QUEEN OF JAZZ and stable companion ICE CAP are capable of running well this course and distance. DARLINGBUDSOFMAY and CAPE CAPRI are two others worth considering.
