Born Slippy has shaped as if he can pay his way going forward and looks the chief danger to Richard Hannon's improving youngster. Woolisle and Alasrae are other notable contenders now they go handicapping.

Only beaten a neck when stepped up to this trip at Doncaster, with the front two clear of the rest, a repeat of that may be all he needs.

Meet Me In Meraki has finished second on his last two starts, but may have to settle for third here.

PREVIEW: Bernard Llewellyn won this last year and seems eager for a repeat having four of the 12 runners, with Mind Hunter possibly the pick after finishing second off this mark over C&D. Sophar Sogood stayed on to win at Catterick but has an added 4lb, and a chance is taken on HICCUPS. Still a maiden after 12 starts, he was left with too much to do in that Catterick race and will hopefully be ridden much nearer to the pace here.
