



HEREFORD (UK) - 26 JANUARY 2026

NOTE: No Quartet bets can be taken at this race meeting

RACECOURSE: A right-handed almost square shaped track about a mile and a half in extent. There are nine stiffish fences per circuit and a run-in of 300 yards. Despite its conformation the track represents a fair test.

TAB BETS for this meeting = ALL RACES: Commingled Win, Place, Exacta, Swinger, Trifecta **NOTE:** SA pools R1 unit, minimum bet R6. COMMINGLED bets no fractional betting, R1 unit, minimum bet R6 except SWINGER R2. EACHWAY bet of R3 Win and R3 Place, as well as 3-horse EXACTA Box or 4-horse SWINGER Box for R6 can be taken. 3-horse Trifecta Box costs R6 (6 combinations @ R1 each). UK Tote Rules: SWINGER = only if 6 or more carded, payout FIRST TWO if 4 or 5 runners, refund if less than 4. QUARTET = carryover if less than 4 finishers. PLACE = less than 5 runners No PLACE betting, 5-7 runners payouts FIRST, SECOND, Handicap race 8-15 payouts FIRST, SECOND, THIRD, 16 or more payouts FIRST, SECOND, THIRD, FOURTH. Non-Handicaps 8 runners or more payouts FIRST, SECOND, THIRD. If any bet includes number higher than 30, call bet to teller. Do not use the betting form. If more than 37 carded TAB operates SA pools on race and all runners numbered 38 and higher are bracketed as Number 37, which can only qualify once for dividend purposes. NOTE: UK tote payouts based on a ONE POUND unit. Commingled TAB bets on UK races are to a R1 unit and qualify for 1/24th of the UK payout. If UK tote payout is 100 POUNDS, TAB payout will be 4.17 POUNDS or about R96 depending on exchange rate

PREVIEW: Just 1lb separates DRACO MALFOY and Big Ticket on official ratings. The latter is favoured in receipt of 7lb but there have to be reservations given that he was pulled up latest, so Kim Bailey and Mat Nicholls' chance is fancied to come out on top. He hit the woodwork under a penalty at Doncaster but had excelled on soft ground prior and that could be crucial today. Handin Manypockets can chase the pair home.

Ski Lodge continues to knock at the door and is unlikely to be far away, whilst Risk De Pluie should benefit from a return to further.

PREVIEW: ROYAL MER has found it difficult to get his head in front for some time now but it hasn't been for the want of trying. The son of Montmarte had the measure of Passing Kate (fifth) and Wewillgowithplanb (eighth) at Exeter. There are questions mark over the remaining pair too, so with Rian Corcoran removing a handy 7lb this looks a fine opportunity. Hors Jeu was by no means out of it when unseating at Lingfield last month and he could be the biggest threat.

PREVIEW: The Evan Williams-trained pair L'astroboy and Out of Office, who represent the same owners, are lightly-raced types that have recently returned after lengthy absences. As the former sets the standard according to the official ratings and the latter has scope from a handy mark, the betting market should be informative where they are concerned. However, the vote goes to NOWMELAD, who has steadily improved since joining Henry Oliver. He is fancied to build on two second-placed finishes posted in competitive events at Market Rasen and Uttoxeter last month.

PREVIEW: STATTLER, who won the National Hunt Chase at the 2022 Cheltenham Festival and runner-up in the 2023 Irish Gold Cup when at his peak for Willie Mullins, is very hard to ignore on his debut in a hunters' chase. The obvious concern is the 653-day absence since he last saw competitive action. However, given that last appearance came in the 2024 Grand National, it's safe to say this level is readily eclipsed by his usual standard. Quel Destin's form under Rules is respected and he is suggested as the biggest danger. Snipe is a logical alternative.

PREVIEW: PRINCESS KERI was many lengths clear when her rider became unbalanced and was unseated after an awkward landing at the last at Fakenham eight days ago. Although the Evan Williams-trained mare doesn't have the recognition, she could almost be considered a winner without a penalty and a safe round can see her put the record straight. Gower Spirit and Ezmerelda can fight it out for second place.
