The son of Calyx showed a bit more when third at Yarmouth last time out and he now steps into handicaps. Fitted with cheekpieces for the first time and off a fair opening mark, it would come as no great surprise were he to find the necessary progress. Saachi is also noted.

PREVIEW COMMENT: FEARNOT's third-placed finish in the Britannia at Royal Ascot was highly commendable. However, that effort was bettered when he successfully returned to the same venue in an identically deep handicap last month. A 6lb higher rating might should be manageable for Clive Cox's progressive colt. Montpellier had Yah Mo Be There a place behind when he finished fourth in a similar event over 7f at Goodwood and can confirm the form with improvement possible over this longer trip. The unbeaten Big Leader is up in class but also merits respect.

He went into last winter with an enhanced reputation after just being beaten a neck in the Dewhurst at Newmarket. He has had two runs this season, in the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket and the Irish equivalent at the Curragh, and finished out the back in both. If he is anywhere near his best, he ought to take plenty of beating. The admirable Fiery Lucy had a tough draw in Galway but, prior to that, had been very consistent. This is a tricky task for Queen Of The Bogs, but she did win a Curragh maiden by almost five lengths so is one to note.
