Out of a half-sister to an American Grade 2 winner, she was well beaten on debut but showed much more on her second start. That form looks reasonable, with the fifth-placed horse stepping forward to win easily next time. The four-year-old Spanish Princess has shown useful form in two starts, while Snapretend displayed improvement in a hood at Limerick and although she drops markedly in distance, she should compete. Pete's Dream may be suited by reverting to this distance.

The booking of Osin Murphy suggests connections mean business and the Jeff Smith-owned filly offers the most intrigue. Red Eve and Betty Lemon are interesting newcomers to keep an eye on.

So Messi is a 22-race maiden who has some useful form this summer and although well held at Dundalk recently, seems better suited by easy turf ground.
