But along with DIANI he has a bit more to do jumping from wider out. IMILENZEYOKUDUDUMA and THE SHEPHERD are both capable of being in the fight too.

NELSON BAY is capable but has drawn widest. There should not be much to choose between hard-knocking ISIKWISHIKWISHI and last start winner AMOR FATI. The former has drawn ideally. IMPOSING and IMPERIAL POWER could go well too.
