Twice a winner in the UK earlier in the season, Small Fry arguably didn't stay when only ninth in the Irish Cesarewitch. Dropped in class, Mont St Michel has to be given maximum respect for Aidan O'Brien too.

Diamond Geezer returned from a break with a respectable second at Worcester last month and is a serious danger with cheekpieces applied. Burning It Up is also unexposed in handicapping terms and has each-way claims.
