Emma Lavelle's charge receives 6lb from the selection and is feared most.

The vote goes to BETTIES BAY, who returned from just over 14 months off the track when scoring at Wolverhampton at the start of the month and a 3lb rise could underestimate her. Others to consider are Lahina Bay and Invincible Melody.
