Convincing, back in mid-division in that same Curragh contest, will be better suited by this distance and he had some good form on easy ground last term.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** A typically tricky early-season three-year-old handicap with more than half of these stepping out of maiden company for the first time. Off bottom weight and representing a stable in form, BALANCE OF TRADE could go well after showing potential in a couple of nurseries on testing ground. His best effort was when beaten less than two lengths at Gowran, where his finishing effort over 7f would give rise to hopes that he may see out this trip. Elm Creek and Acceleireight both wear first-time headgear on handicap debut and represent respected yards, while Dreoilin has the benefit of a recent run where she stayed on over 6f in a Curragh maiden.
