PREVIEW COMMENT: SKIPPINANDAJUMPIN showed plenty of promise when beating all bar Spanish Temptress at Killarney earlier this month and makes a quick reappearance following an unlucky effort over this trip at the Curragh on Thursday. The Joseph O'Brien-trained filly was well-backed in that 26-runner event and finished a creditable sixth despite being continually denied a clear passage. Both Pandion Power and Irish Rumour filled the runners-up spot on their respective latest starts and will not be inconvenienced by any rain, while others for the shortlist include Vlhoava and Stormie Outlook who are closely matched on running at Listowel last time.

PREVIEW COMMENT: A winner between the flags, BLUE TOPAZ finished a respectable fourth in a bumper at Uthtoeter on her first start for Fergal O'Brien. The winner has since followed up in and the daughter of Blue Bresil can land this with improvement likely. Ivan's Legacy faded out of contention in the closing stages at Hexham on his racecourse debut but could feature if learning to settle, while Art Dancer is worth a second look ahead of his introduction.
