Karl Burke's gelding ran on well to win over 7f in the Newcastle event in which Great Dream was third and can only improve for both the run and the extra furlong.

BJORN IRONSIDE races well fresh and is weightied to be competitive on his reappearance. NYAKA NYAKA showed promise as a 2yo, has scope to improve, and the form to make his presence felt. BAKWENA, FROZEN FANTASY and PRINCE OF KILDARE shouldn't be far off the mark.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** Having shown a willing attitude to score in the shadows of the post at Newmarket earlier this month, Rogue Diplomat warrants respect in his follow-up bid. However, a 3lb rise in the ratings and switch to the all-weather does demand more from James Owen's colt and it could be worth taking a punt on PHILANTHROPIST. The son of Sergei Prokofiev is returning to the C&D of his last triumph and looks more than capable of scoring at this level. Fondo Blanco is also noted.
