Narrowly denied after a luckless run over C&D on debut, the son of Kingman stepped forward with a ready success in a notable maiden back here. With more to come, he's an exciting prospect. Similar comments apply to Pacific Avenue, who looked professional on his winning debut at Newmarket and the Godolphin-owned colt must be taken seriously. The class-dropping Humidity and Beverley maiden winner He's Walim complete the shortlist.

PREVIEW COMMENT: HAPPY VERSE won two nice races to start off his career. He was not disgraced last time out and can bounce back to score. NILE THE BOSS is knocking at the door but this does look a tougher race. LADY LOOK ALIVE is consistent and should run well for jockey Richard Fourie. GOLDEN ANGEL has not won for some time but does get a lot of weight from some of his rivals and could be ready for a decent performance. ARBITRATION is consistent and should be right there at the finish. CARRIACOU needed his last run and could be the surprise package of the race.

ROCKANROLLIN has run well in both starts but is badly drawn.

SELECTION: 5 KINSWOMAN 8 BONNIE'S BOY 3 ZIGGY'S TRITON

PREVIEW COMMENT: A low draw and early speed is advantageous over the 5f here and that leads to the chances of KINSWOMAN, who got off the mark at the sixth attempt when winning at Windsor. Inclined to race freely, if she is given her head from the one stall she may be able to put this to bed early. Ziggy's Triton might try to live with her from the off, while York third Bonnie's Boy is an interesting alternative.
