The Andy Oliver-trained filly can hopefully progress again, and any rain should help her cause. Zoffman won this race off a mark of 85 back in 2022 and after missing most of the following season, has been generally consistent since. He didn't enjoy a clear run when a close fourth behind Fleetfoot in the valuable Ragusa Handicap over this trip at the Curragh on Irish Derby Day and should be suited by this return to 1m4f. Navy Waters and recent Curragh winner Retracement are others to consider.
