PREVIEW COMMENT: OBSCENITY is a tentative selection here as he bids to open his account. The son of Fastnet Rock was sent off joint favourite on debut, but failed to show much on that occasion and similar comments apply for the rest of his maiden runs. Joseph O'Brien's charge provided some encouragement on his handicap bow and better is expected up in trip. Alfalfa is capable of being in the mix after his victory here over 1m4f at the start of the month, while others to note include Convincing and Chica Guerrera.

He's won both starts for Charlie Clover's yard by a wide margin, including last week's four-length romp at Brighton, and is hard to oppose with Alexandra Egan's allowance in the plate negating his latest penalty. Amarachi won over C&D on her handicap debut and could land a blow representing last year's winning trainer, while Respectable Jack won't be far away.
