AFRICAN SKYLINE came in for support in a high-class race last time and didn't disgrace himself. He could be rewarded. SOHO STAR wasn't far off champion Gladiatorian and could show the strength of that form line. But he has drawn widest. ICY BLAST was a gutsy winner at this course before running an equally decent race on the Polytrack. He has drawn well and comes into it along with lightly raced but progressive POSITION OF POWER. TARA STAR will have her say too.

She enjoys the track and trip and should have every chance from a plum stall. LUCKY DOLLAR ran out a fluent winner from the front last time and could repeat even if having drawn widest. It doesn't end there.

PREVIEW COMMENT: IMPOSING is in hot form over 1400m and will try and get the timing right over 1600m this time. WICCAN WARRIOR could be the one to turn the form around with IMPOSING. He ran on well to finish 1.05 lengths behind the former, is now 2kg better off and prefers the longer distance. KITCHAKAL is another serious contender on form. He has yet to win at this track but that could change as he has drawn ideally. ETIQUETTE and WINTER GAMES have the form needed to be right there if the race is run to suit. TREATY OF PARIS, GO GRAYSON GO and TIRPITZ are not out of it either.

HOW TO READ FIELDS: Runner info shown as follows: Number; Horse; Age; colour; sex; Trainer; Draw (position in starting gate); Jockey; Weight to be carried included rider & equipment; Last 3 runs with most recent on right. After horse name: *=Blinkers; !=Pacifiers; ()=Blinkers/Pacifiers; \$=Cheek Pieces; x=Eye Shield; ‡=Visor; ?=Hood; ^=Ear Muffs; *=apprentice. Last three runs are shown in order of finishing position; racecourse; distance; lengths beaten. Thus 3V12 is third at Vaal over 1200m. If underscored 1T12, the race followed a rest of 60 days or more.
