PREVIEW COMMENT: STANAGE won a division of this race 12 months ago from a 7lb higher mark and he ended last season with some encouraging efforts in defeat. With that in mind, it would be no surprise to see him repeat that success. Epictetus was only beaten a neck into second over 7f at Chelmsford recently and is likely to be in the mix once again. Others to note are Miletus, Red Mirage and Capital Guarantee.

PREVIEW COMMENT: DARLINGBUDSOFMAY and FUTANO are out of sorts but weighted to be competitive. ONE IRISH ROVER and IN THE BAG are closely matched on recent course-and-distance form. Both have the credentials to win a race like this and there shouldn't be much separating them. L'ULTIMO had legitimate excuses in his comeback outing and should not be ignored. LITTLE CRACKER and stablemate QUINCY TOWN have shown enough to also warrant consideration.

That said, HARVEY caught the eye when third over a mile at Kempton recently and this unexposed four-year-old may improve significantly now stepped up in trip. Port Of London represents top connections and should not be underestimated, while Atherstone Warrior edges out Castle Stuart and Spioradalta to be next best.

PREVIEW COMMENT: With five defeats to her name this season, HARD DEALT has proved expensive to follow. Although a 3lb higher mark for her latest second at Haydock will only make life tougher for Henry Daly's mare, she is unexposed over this sort of trip and could be poised to repay her supporters. Kilworth was too bad to be true when pulled up at Plumpton 34 days ago and better is expected over this longer distance. Handicap debutant Joyau Allen is a feasible alternative.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Having ended his three-year-old campaign with a head second at Newmarket, it could be worth chancing SIXTYGEESBABY in an open contest. Now under the tutelage of David O'Meara, the son of Starspangledbanner has a fine record fresh and he may be able to defy a 2lb rise in the ratings. Territorial Knight was last seen finishing a good fifth in the Ayr Bronze Cup in September and he must enter the reckoning, along with fellow C&D winners Fine Interview and Lord Bertie.
