PREVIEW COMMENT: Another interesting race with some in-form runners. FAIRY KNIGHT is the class act and has won many times on the Polytrack so gets the narrow choice. Stable companion MERCANTOUR has improved on this surface of late and will not go down without a fight. Another Alan Greeff-trained runner, DUBAI HILLS, is very brave but this is his toughest take to date. PAS DE NOM is clearly a lot better than his last run. CHAMPONELLE ran well above her rating when scoring last time out. GOLDEN PAVILION is in the form of his life and is not out of it.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Lady Iman has stolen all of the headlines leading up to this event as she was supplemented after her Molecomb triumph last month and the daughter of Starman is worth her place at this level. Course winner Jm Jungle produced a career-best when defeating She's Quality by a neck in a Group 2 at Goodwood earlier in the month and it would be no surprise to see him confirm that form. However, Commonwealth Cup silver medalist ARIZONA BLAZE looks the way to go. Adrian Murray's three-year-old accounted for Mgheera by two lengths in a Group 2 at the Curragh on his most recent start and can continue his upward trajectory.

WINTER WARFARE did too much too soon last time out and should run well from a good draw. WORDSWORTH is clearly better than his last run and does like this surface so must be respected for that. CRUZADOR is consistent and can contest the finish. KING VISERYS and CASINO ACE are both capable of being dangers if running to their best Western Cape form.

The Gosdens' filly showed a huge amount of improvement when bolting up at Leicester last month and considering the manner of that triumph, she might defy her 11lb rise.

Slowly away that day, he stayed on well enough to suggest stepping up to 7f should be fine. Frescobaldi represents Aidan O'Brien/Ballydoyle and appeals after two promising starts in Ireland. However, this race is about deep potential and none fits the bill more than INISHBEG. Having cost 500,000gns as a yearling, the son of Ghaithyath runs for highly respected connections whose decision to pitch him at this level on debut is a telling indication of expectations. New Monarch and Beny Nahar are other compelling options.
