He has decent recent 1400m form but has won over this distance. MVELELO's second career win is overdue. He has run well in strong contests and having drawn well should give a good account of himself. TEATIME TIPPLE should also go well from a plum gate but QUERARI'S DREAM has a better record at the track, has gate No 1 and carries a light weight. RECORD HIGH impressed last time. TOTAL SURRENDER is the dark horse.

Persica also reverts to today's distance with solid claims on his defeat of last year's winner Ice Max in the Diomed at Epsom in June, while Listed winner Make Me King is not out of it either.
