Last-start winners TIME WILL TELL and JET CAT should be competitive for Swinger and Exakta berths, while hard-knockers TOGETHER AGAIN, ORIENTAL BOUQUET and STROKE OF MERCY are others to consider for Trifecta and Quartet bets.

Rebecca Menzies' sprinter returns to the minimum trip 5lb lower than when finishing third at Thirsk in June. The first two home have subsequently franked that form and a bold bid is anticipated from the son of Havana Gold. Beaumadier and Sixcor are others to consider.

Lesley's Boy is the pick of Richard Fahey's pair and he completes the shortlist.

SELECTION: 1 AFTER HOURS 12 COMMANDER OF ALL 3 COPPOLA 9 GAMER **PREVIEW COMMENT:** Veteran hard-knocker AFTER HOURS defied a 3-point penalty for winning at this level by following up against stronger opposition last time and a further 4-point rise back in this grade is unlikely to prevent him from completing the hat-trick. COPPOLA, class-dropper PANNING GOLD, hard-knockers FLAG BEARER and GAMER, as well as consistent ZOOMBOMBER all have earning potential. However, a bigger threat to the selection will likely come from COMMANDER OF ALL who stayed on to finish a close-up 3rd last time and is 2kg better off with his last-start conqueror for a 2.05-length beating.

Hinitsa Bay followed up his Yarmouth win with a runner-up effort at the same venue and is an obvious threat to the selection, while recent Beverley third Overlooked is next best.

PACIFIERS OFF: WILDERNESS. **SELECTION:** 3 SEÑOR CORTEZ 1 MOEL ARTHUR 6 THRONE HALL **PREVIEW COMMENT:** SEÑOR CORTEZ was a wide-margin winner over 1m6f at Yarmouth and reverts to the all-weather with a big chance of following up, despite an 8lb rise. Henry Callan allowed the son of Sea The Stars to coast home in that race, which left the impression that stepping up in trip won't be much of an issue. Moel Arthur, a previous C&D winner, looks the chief danger to the selection, although Throne Hall is another doughty stayer to consider.
