He is still unexposed and may just enjoy the turn. Specialist SUPER FAST will not make things easy. He lived up to his name last time and is arguably better on the grass track at this venue. ICY BLAST showed guts to win and having drawn well again must be respected. HIERKOMMIEBOKKIE is best weighted and has gate No 1. If she is in the right mood she could be right there. ISIKWISHIKWISHI and TARA STAR (loves the track) aren't without claims either. Nice race.

That was the seven-year-old's fifth victory in his last six outings and he looks capable of defying a 9lb hike in the ratings. Fairlawn Flyer has also enjoyed a productive year and found only a subsequent winner too strong at Cartmel in July. However, Mickey Bowen's charge is sitting on a career-high mark and Newton Abbot winner Bagheera Ginge may give the selection most to think about.

FATE OF FORTUNE wasn't beaten far by a smart youngster last time. He is in good form and must be included in all bets. BOOM SHAKALAKA has won over the distance and could prove to be a bit more competitive in this lower division. He is racing after a rest but has drawn well. YANNAKIS won a nice race in his penultimate start and is worth another chance. CATAVAR has been doing well over 1000m and yet should be better over 1200m-he could show up strongly. NAVAJO DANCER is one of many that can earn.

The Andy Oliver-trained filly can hopefully progress again, and any rain should help her cause. Zoffman won this race off a mark of 85 back in 2022 and after missing most of the following season, has been generally consistent since. He didn't enjoy a clear run when a close fourth behind Fleetfoot in the valuable Ragusa Handicap over this trip at the Curragh on Irish Derby Day and should be suited by this return to 1m4f. Navy Waters and recent Curragh winner Retracement are others to consider.

Dickens arrives in fine fettle having notched up a brace of wins at Newton Abbot prior to finishing second over C&D latest. He's preferred to Perth runner-up Park Annonciade of the rest.

PREVIEW COMMENT: GOLD LINK represents last year's winning yard and could prove the one to side with in an open affair. He found one too good when favourite at Fontwell last month, but has won off a much higher mark over fences and looks worth another chance. Him Malaya returns to the fray only 2lb higher than when successful under today's rider at Taunton at the end of last year, while Jefe Triunfo is another to consider.
