DYLAN'S CHAMP showed good resolve to win over 1600m last time. He is in good form and may not mind the drop to 1400m. DECEPTION PASS has a few lengths to find on DYLAN'S CHAMP but his last run was decent and must be respected. ZANTHAR has dropped in merit ratings and now has a 2.5kg apprentice claim and could be the dark horse. JORDAN could benefit from a decent pace. JURY'S OUT is another that can take it.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** HURSTWOOD had excuses when sixth here last week, missing the start before keeping on to finish sixth. A winner the time before at Nottingham, the eight-year-old remains fairly treated and could get back on track if breaking on terms. Crocodile Power has to enter the reckoning, despite a 4lb penalty for scoring at Catterick, while Diligent Henry and Rain Cap appear best of the remainder.
