PREVIEW: Bay Dream Believer beat Little Ted by a neck over track and trip 10 days ago and that form is likely to be upheld. Triple Force has taken the silver medal home the last twice and should remain competitive, but POET'S DAWN gets the nod. The veteran could only manage third in a stronger event over C&D on his latest outing, but shared the spoils at Beverley prior and is just 2lb higher here.

PREVIEW: Schrodinger's Cat brings plenty of experience to the table and sets the standard with an official rating of 78, but he has failed to justify favouritism in each of his last two starts and NOBLE VOW makes more appeal. Richard Hannon's colt shaped with promise when third on debut over 6f at Salisbury and if the son of No Nay Never takes a step forward from that performance, he could prove hard to beat. Any market support behind newcomer Lady Kodiac would be interesting.

That run can safely be forgiven and and he is better judged on his ready success over 2m at Newmarket on his previous appearance. Sea Master has form that ties in with the runner-up from that race and can figure if perked up by first-time cheekpieces. Regally Blonde and Lillistar complete the shortlist.
