The latter emphatically won a classified stakes at Chepstow, before edging an apprentice rider's handicap at Haydock. However, a 4lb rise demands more, so William Haggas' filly shades the vote. She made a belated winning seasonal debut at Ffos Las and a 2lb rise should be more than manageable. Dragonflame and Pay Attention can fight it out for the minor spoils.

Solar Pass is yet another with an each-way chance.
