PREVIEW: Sanbona got off the mark at this level at Wolverhampton recently and his chance is there for all to see. Little Beck Annie hasn't fired in both of her handicap starts at Beverley, but the booking of Paul Mulrennan catches the eye and she is one to keep an eye on. However, CROCUS TIME fared best of those that were ridden on the pace when third over C&D earlier in the month and a repeat of that effort could suffice.
