Both DOESYOURMOTHERKNOW (3rd) and MOANA (2nd) are closely matched on that form and likely to pose a threat on 3kg better terms. PROUD MARY will also be wiser to the task after a pleasing 1200m introduction and this extended trip could be more to her liking.

PREVIEW: PRAYERSANDPROMISES confirmed the promise of his debut 3rd by winning last time and the form of that victory was boosted by the subsequent runaway success of re-opposing DEAR DOC. With the step up to this distance likely to unlock further improvement, the former ought to confirm his superiority. HIGHWAY CODE, PARACHUTE ADAMS and WHAT A WARRIOR could make their presence felt if building on encouraging recent performances. Well-bred Rafeef colt MEGA AWESOME is one to note and worth a market check on debut.

Consistent GIMMETHEGOODLIFE, hat-trick seeking THE SPECIALIST and last-start winner VIBE SA should also acquire themselves competitively. LEAD THE CHARGE and PLUS FOUR could make their presence felt too on the evidence of their improved recent performances.

PREVIEW: UNSOLVED RIDDLE was rewarded for consistency with a last-start victory at this level and a resultant 4-point penalty isn't likely to halt his momentum. However, 3yo filly FRANGIPANI takes a considerable drop in class so could represent the value at this level after consecutive feature-race appearances. She should fare better in these calmer waters, even under a big weight against male opposition. GUERRILLA WARFARE, DECEPTION PASS, CHIEFTAIN'S SHIELD and MOCHA FRAPPE are capable hard-knockers with the means to pose a threat, especially off their reduced ratings. PEREGRINE FALCON isn't overlooked.

JIMMY DON is the best-weighted runner in the lineup but unlikely to be at his peak in his second outing after a lengthy layoff, so last-start winner KING HARALD and consistent DANCE KING should pose more of a threat. GERBERA could improve fitted with cheekpieces for the first time so cannot be underestimated either.

THERE SHE GOES and BOSUM BUDDY have the form and experience to make their presence felt too. Unexposed FIERY ROSE isn't taken lightly on her handicap debut after a break.

Fellow 3yo fillies TEMPRANILLO and LOVABLE have fewer miles on the clock and won't need to improve much to get into the picture. Class-droppers SHE'S ALL MINE and KIA KAHAA should make their presence felt in this grade off reduced ratings. MY DEAR FRIEND is another to consider on her handicap debut.
