Low-mileage three-year-olds Jet Black and Pergola are feared more than the veteran Carp Kid, with the former rated the biggest danger now cheekpieces are added.

The son of Invincible Spirit was able to take advantage of a sliding handicap mark when successful at Brighton latest. All Too Beautiful is another to consider.

Recent course winner Gogo Yubari merits respect under the penalty, while others to note include Phoenix Moon and Due Date.
