The son of Blue Point fetched 340,000gns as a yearling whilst being related to a host of useful individuals, so it would come as no great surprise were he good enough to land the spoils. Warning Symbol won't find this as taxing as the Goodwood maiden he contested latest and first-time cheekpieces could spark some improvement.

However, preference is for TWOSTEP QUEEN whose performances at a higher level as well as her rider's 4kg allowance should stand her in good stead. BOOM BOOM, ANNEWITHAN E, CARTAGENA and last-start winner KISS OF FIRE are also capable of having a say in the outcome.
