PREVIEW COMMENT: Whatsgoingonmarvin has improved likely many of Sir Mark Prescott's horses do once they go handicapping, and the Camelot gelding must be taken seriously. However, the eye is drawn to LIVONIAN's unexposed profile and, providing he can settle better on his handicap debut, Ralph Beckett's impressive Windsor scorer could be hard to beat back on the grass. Others to consider include the hat-trick seeking Spirit Lead Me and Tipsy Tiger.
