The latter is 1lb better off today, though, and whilst also boasting an advantageous draw, he could reverse that form. However, a chance can be taken on DOUBLE NAUGHTY. The daughter of Cotai Glory showed bright speed over 6f when finishing third at Thirsk on her nursery bow. A drop in trip should aid her cause along with the forecast quicker ground.

PREVIEW COMMENT: Whatsgoingonmarvin has improved likely many of Sir Mark Prescott's horses do once they go handicapping, and the Camelot gelding must be taken seriously. However, the eye is drawn to LIVONIAN's unexposed profile and, providing he can settle better on his handicap debut, Ralph Beckett's impressive Windsor scorer could be hard to beat back on the grass. Others to consider include the hat-trick seeking Spirit Lead Me and Tippy Tiger.
