However, he has drawn wide along with promising last start winner COUNCILLOR who could improve enough to beat this type of opposition. GARDENER'S PRIDE has drawn wider out but could overcome the hurdle early after a nice win on the Poly from the front. PIED PIPER has potential and could prefer a change in tactics.
