Fellow class-droppers CLAIRWOOD ROSE and INAFIX should also acquit themselves competitively at this level off reduced marks. HIS LORDSHIP and recent runner-up, albeit at a lower level, NKANDLA GOLD have earning potential too.

PREVIEW COMMENT: 2024 Derby runner-up AMBIENTE FRIENDLY should have learned plenty from his fourth-placed hurdle debut at Cheltenham and makes grand appeal. The four-year-old showed signs of inexperience and this emphasis on speed is likely to suit. Wondering Why arrives on the back of a promising third at Southwell and may give the selection most to think about, although it would be no surprise to see Bobajob bounce back to form tackling timber for the first time.
