Fitted with cheekpieces for the first time and off a fair opening mark, it would come as no great surprise were he to find the necessary progress. Saachi is also noted.

Saxophonist is another likely to appreciate this longer trip based on his promising third at Newcastle, while Mr Colonel is related to three winners on the Flat and is a newcomer to note.

**PREVIEW COMMENT:** FEARNOT's third-placed finish in the Britannia at Royal Ascot was highly commendable. However, that effort was bettered when he successfully returned to the same venue in an identically deep handicap last month. A 6lb higher rating might should be manageable for Clive Cox's progressive colt. Montpellier had Yah Mo Be There a place behind when he finished fourth in a similar event over 7f at Goodwood and can confirm the form with improvement possible over this longer trip. The unbeaten Big Leader is up in class but also merits respect.

This is a tricky task for Queen Of The Bogs, but she did win a Curragh maiden by almost five lengths so is one to note.
